Participated in many national, international exhibitions all over the world and had solo exhibitions in different countries.



Artist's Statement

In my work I always try to use colour schemes that show a special emotional expression just by their pure existence. It's my passion to work with colour and to combine an utmost high accuracy of the drawing overall, as well as carefully placed details and a special texture of the painting. This allows to combine colour and tonal rhythms, creates an emotional mood through colour, light and composition. Most time I do see the whole picture in all details before I start working. It appears in my dreams and stays in my imagination before being brought to life on a canvas.

After years of painting in realistic style I've started to experiment with new painting techniques and expressed myself by other methods. This resulted in a series of works which were completely different to my beginning, extended my capabilities and palette.

Painting enables me to express a kind of balance between the emotional and the philosophical world. I often combine realistic concepts with transcendental sensitivity and try to unite seemingly incompatible ideas: powerful expression and grace, clarity and complexity, clear roots in the art of the past, but with its own modern graphic language.

There is always a sense of care behind the placement and execution of any detail of the painting as well as of the whole piece of art itself. Often complementary colours are put in their natural purity on the canvas where just the representation of a flame illuminates and shows the imaginative approach of the work. The energy of the flame symbolically stands for spiritual energy.

Bold colours like sky-blue, ruby-red, emrald-green and yellow sometimes compete with one another in ways not seen in nature but it is the balance of these colours that make the composition seem completely natural. Objects and background are treated equally in their importance for the overall work and it's harmony. My work is based on my religious beliefs and often addresses the clash of an ideal spiritual world with the cruel reality we are living in. My aspiration is to reveal the spiritual part of human life.
